Course Outline & Course Requirements

The CCAP certification course is divided into 4 modules over 12 months, with a 5th weekend session for the exam component. Each module runs from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on a Saturday and Sunday.

Module 1 introduces the core concepts of clinical aromatherapy; history, taxonomy, extraction, safety, evidence-based and research driven. 10 essential oils are introduced.

Module 2 outlines the chemistry of essential oils, functional groups and 10 more essential oils are introduced.

Module 3 covers the use of essential oils for immune support, cardiovascular, respiratory, digestive, muscular skeletal and stress control within a healthcare framework. Tutorial on student exam project.

Module 4 covers women's health, pediatrics, elderly, chronic pain, cancer, and palliative care. Integration: policies and protocols. Exam prep. Second tutorial on exam project. 10 new essential oils are introduced.

Session 5: Two-part Certification Exam: written paper and presentation of project. Results are externally assessed. Successful completion of both parts is required for certification as a Certified Clinical Aromatherapy Practitioner (CCAP). Each participant must also complete 40 case studies over the course of the year.

Additional associated costs:

A.) Participants must purchase and bring to each module the book: *Clinical Aromatherapy: Essential Oils in Healthcare* (3rd ed.) by Jane Buckle PhD.
B.) Essential oils, which vary in price from \$100 - \$150 per module, must be purchased on site from the presenter.
